To become gastroenterologist in Iraq ,one has to be an internist first, the later involve residency program in teaching hospitals for at least four years, passing written, oral and clinical examination as well as submission of thesis on one of a medical problem. when all these requirements are fulfilled successfully, the candidate will be board certified in internal medicine, the candidate then will be eligible to enter gastroenterology training. The curriculum for gastroenterology training include:-

- 1. Three years of full time residency during which the candidate will be responsible for patients care in the outpatients and in the gastroenterology wards.
- 2. The candidate is expected to be actively involved in medical meeting, radiology meeting, journal clubs, death conference & histopathology meeting.
- 3. The candidate should submit a thesis on one of the gastroenterological problem.
- 4. The candidate is expected to perform the following procedures during his training:-
